Quote from the Holy Fathers:

This is the Pascha of Christ, our Redeemer. Christ Himself became the Lamb Who redeemed mankind, when His most pure Blood, which spilled on the ground, freed us from eternal death. As the Saviour of the world, Christ rose from the dead on the third day and divided the people into two camps: those who believe in Him, and those who persecute His believers. His first greeting after His Resurrection was 'Rejoice!' The holy apostles never tired of repeating after Christ, 'Rejoice, evermore!' because a great reward is prepared for us in the heavens... The doors of paradise are opened to those who follow God's commandments, and they will be led into the new, sacred Jerusalem, where the Lord Himself will wipe away all tears. No longer will there be death or weeping, moaning or sickness. Truly He is risen!'
